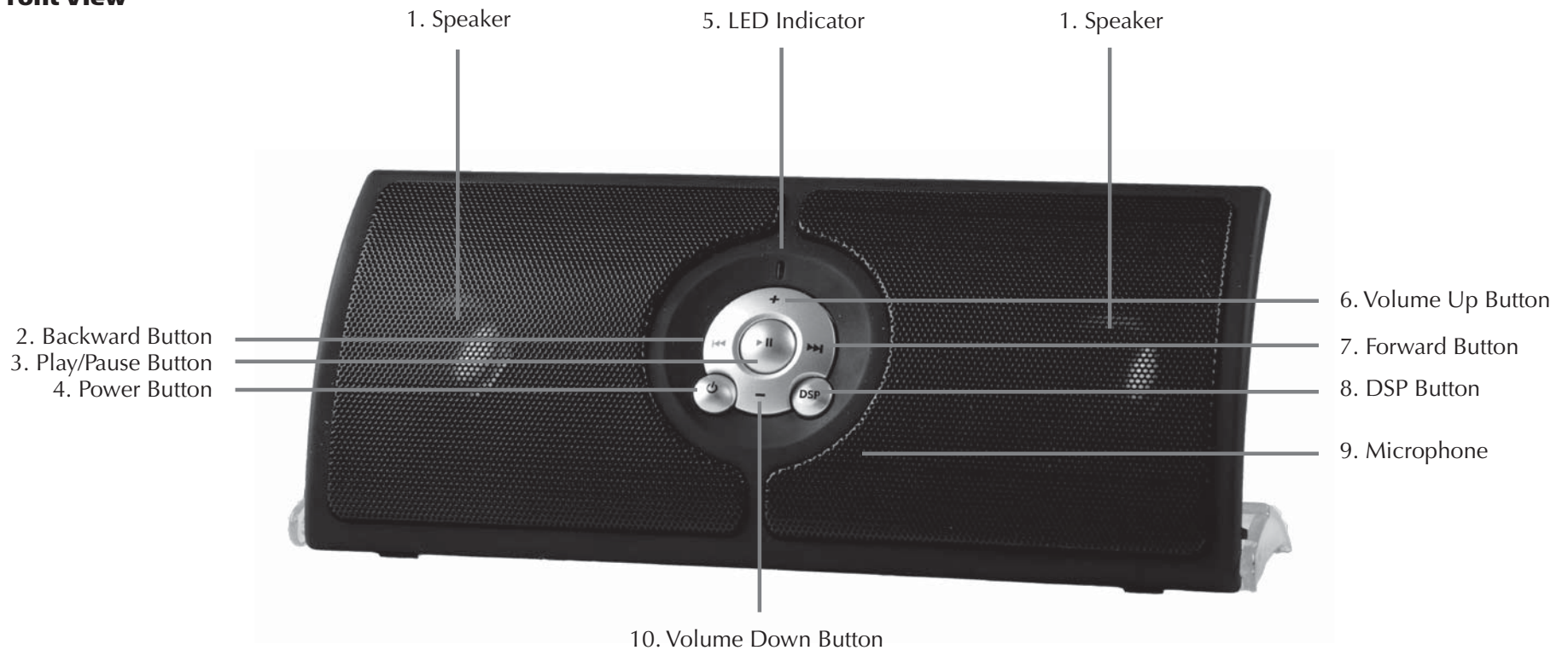
## 1. Product Description

The BluBridge Mobile Speaker is a portable, Bluetooth enabled sound system and speakerphone. The excellent stereo sound lets you enjoy your music without the inconvenience of wires. The innovation continues with built in noise cancellation technology allowing you to enjoy crystal-clear, echo-free phone and Skype calls. We've also added Waves MaxxBass technology which provides more bass response and warmth for your listening enjoyment.

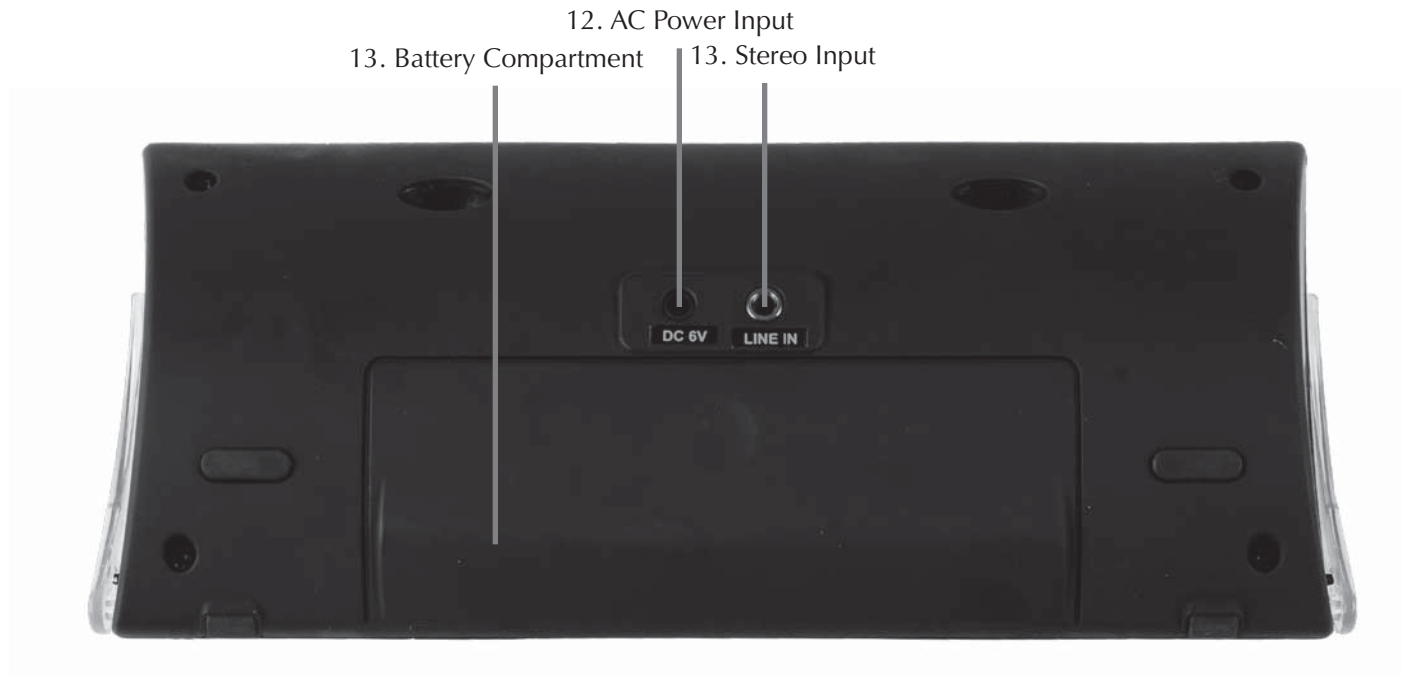
Connect your iPod and phone to the speaker simultaneously and never miss a call! The sleek and elegant design plus the ease of use make this product a must-have for any portable music fan. Use anywhere the music mood strikes; in and around the home, at the office, out with friends, by the pool or on a boat; the possibilities are endless.

## 3. Power

Battery- use 4AA batteries.

- Low Battery Indicator- LED Indicator (5) will flash Red and speaker will beep every 20 seconds.

AC adapter or USB adapter- connect to AC Power Input (12).

- The mobile speaker can be powered continuously by using one of the included power adapters.

## 4. Turning On and Off

- On: Press and hold the power button (4), the LED Indicator (5) will flash Blue and speaker will beep.
- Off: Press and hold the power button (4) for 3 seconds; the LED Indicator (5) will flash Red and speaker will beep.

## 5. Wireless 'Pairing'

To hear wireless music, the mobile speaker must first 'pair' with another Bluetooth enabled device.

## **5.1 Pairing with a Mobile Device**

Important: Your mobile phone must support the Bluetooth music profile A2DP (Advance Audio Distribution Profile). Please refer to the phone's manufacturer website for specifications.

1. From the OFF state, press and hold the power button until the LED indicator flashes Red and Blue, this indicates that the mobile speaker is ready to pair.
2. While in pairing mode, access the Bluetooth menu of your mobile phone. Turn on the Bluetooth function and execute a Bluetooth search to find the mobile speaker. (Please refer to your mobile phone instructions on how to connect a Bluetooth device to your specific model.)
3. When the mobile phone displays a list of found Bluetooth devices, select the BluBridge Mobile Speaker.
4. Once you select the BluBridge Mobile Speaker from the found devices list, your mobile phone will request a password/pin code. Enter 0000 then press OK. You will either automatically be connected or you will need to select 'connect' on your mobile phone to pair the device successfully. The LED Indicator will turn to a blinking Blue once connected.
  - (Note: If a Bluetooth connection is not established within two minutes, you may need to re-start the pairing process).

## **5.2 Pairing with PC/Laptop:**

You need to either have a Bluetooth USB dongle with A2DP support or a PC/Mac with a built-in Bluetooth capable of A2DP. (Windows XP/2, Vista or higher; Mac OSX 10.5 or higher).

1. From the OFF state, press and hold the power button until the LED Indicator flashes Red and Blue, this indicates that the mobile speaker is ready to pair.
2. Now, access the Bluetooth feature of your PC. (Please refer to your software's user manual for instructions on how to pair and connect to a device.) When prompted enter pin/pass code 0000.
3. If pairing is successful, the LED Indicator on the speaker changes to a slow blinking Blue color.
4. If pairing is unsuccessful, turn the mobile speaker Off and repeat above steps.

Depending on the dongle/software/Laptop used, the Bluetooth connection will be made automatically or will need to be manually started via the software menu (please see the USB dongle manufacturer instructions).

### **5.3 Pairing with BluBridge for iPod or Mini-Jack:**

1. From the OFF state, press and hold the power button until the LED Indicator flashes Red and Blue, this indicates that the mobile speaker is ready to pair.
2. If using the BluBridge mini-jack, press and hold the mini-jack's power button until the LED flashes Red and Blue. Once both devices are in pairing mode, simply place them next to each other and wait 10-20 seconds. When pairing has occurred the LED will blink Blue. Then insert the mini-jack into the headphone jack on your audio device.
3. If using the BluBridge for iPod, simply insert the adapter into your iPod or iPhone and the Blue LED on the bottom will begin to flash rapidly. Place the iPod next to the mobile speaker and within 10-20 seconds the LED on the iPod transmitter and the mobile speaker will begin to flash Blue slowly. This indicates pairing has occurred. Now press play on your iPod and enjoy.

### **5.4 Pairing Two Devices**

The BluBridge Mobile Speaker allows you to pair devices containing different profiles to the speaker at the same time. To pair two devices such as an iPod and a mobile phone:

1. Pair your mobile phone with the speaker (section 5.1).
2. Turn off the Bluetooth function on the phone and turn off the speaker.
3. Turn the speaker on and re-enter pairing mode (section 5.3).
4. Pair your music device with the speaker (section 5.2-5.3).
5. Turn on your mobile phone's Bluetooth; select BluBridge Mobile Speaker from the phone, if not automatically reconnected.

## **6 Listening to Wireless Music**

- You can only stream/listen to stereo wireless music if your device supports the Bluetooth A2DP profile.

### **6.1 Music from Mobile Phone**

- Once paired with your mobile phone, even while listening to music, you will still be able to receive and answer calls. When a call is received, the music playing through your mobile speaker will be paused/muted. You can then answer the incoming call with no interruptions (press Power Button (4) to answer the call or the answer button on your mobile phone). The music will resume once your call is ended or rejected.

## 6.2 Music from PC/Laptop

If your computer's Bluetooth software support A2DP, you will be able to stream music from your PC directly to the mobile speaker.

Note:

- Some computers may require you to manually set-up the audio output. In this case, please set the output of audio using the sound control panel on your computer.
- Various Bluetooth software packages (e.g. BlueSoleil) require you to select the correct profile for music streaming. Bluetooth (A2DP) Advanced Audio Service needs to be enabled and connected and for music streaming; and Bluetooth (HSP) Headset Service needs to be enabled for talking.



## 6.3 Music from Non-Bluetooth Devices

At the back of the mobile speaker is a Stereo Line Input (12); use this to directly connect audio sources using the supplied 3.5 mm cable.

- Plug the audio cable into the Stereo Line Input (12) on the back of the mobile speaker and place the other end into the output of your audio device.
- Press the Play Button on your audio device to hear music via the mobile speaker and place the other end into the output of your audio device.
- When the Stereo Line Input (12) is in use, you cannot control the music player via control buttons.

Note: If a device is connected to the Stereo Line Input a second device cannot be paired wirelessly with the speaker. For track and volume control use your music player's buttons directly. However, you can still adjust the volume and mute settings from the mobile speaker buttons.

## 7. Call Related Functions

Answering and ending a call:

- When there is an incoming call, press the Power Button (4) to answer the call or accept the call via your mobile phone.

To end your call:

- Press the Power Button (4) or end the call via your mobile phone.

Voice dialing:

- Press Power Button (4) once and say the name of your pre-recorded contact.

Redial last outgoing number:

- Press Power Button (4) twice for last number redial.

Call Inter-change:

- Speaker to phone- During a conversation, click the Power Button (4) twice quickly; the call will be transferred to your mobile phone.
- Phone to speaker- Click the Power Button (4) once; the call will be transferred to the speaker.

DSP Mute Mode:

- In the midst of a conversation, press the DSP Button (8) to mute your microphone so others on the call cannot hear you.

DSP Bass Enhancement:

- In music mode, the DSP Button (8) activates Waves MaxxBass for increased bass response, and warmth.

VoIP from PC:

- On your PC, make sure the Bluetooth Headset Profile or Hands Free Profile is connected to allow talking through the mobile speaker.

Pairing Mode	Off	Power Button (4)	3 Seconds	LED Indicator (5) flashes Red and Blue quickly and gives 2 short beeps.
Volume +	On	Volume Up Button (6)	One Click	You can also press and hold.
Volume -	On	Volume Down Button (10)	One Click	You can also press and hold.
Disconnect from Mobile Device	On and Connected	Power Button (4)	3 Seconds	LED Indicator (5) flashes red 3 times quickly and gives a long beep.
Voice Dialing	On and Connected	Power Button (4)	One Click	
Answer and End a Call	On and Connected	Power Button (4)	One Click	
Redial last Number	On and Connected	Power Button (4)	2 Quick Clicks	One long beep.
Call Interchange	During Conversation speaker-to-phone	Power Button (4)	2 Quick Clicks

## **11. Care and Maintenance**

Do not expose the mobile speaker directly to liquid, moisture or high humidity, as it is not waterproof.

Clean the mobile speaker with a damp towel, if necessary.

Do not expose the mobile speaker to sharp objects, as this could cause scratching and damage.

Do not attempt to disassemble the mobile speaker; it does not contain user serviceable components.

If you do not use the speaker for long periods of time, be sure to store it in a dry place, free from extreme temperatures, humidity, and dust.

## **12. Safety Information**

Check local laws regarding use of a mobile phone and speakerphone while driving. If you use the mobile speaker while driving, ensure that your attention and focus remain on the road.

Never allow children to play with mobile speaker. Small parts may be a choking hazard.

Observe all signs that require an electrical device or RF radio product to be switched off in the designated areas. These could include hospitals, blasting areas, and potentially explosive atmospheres.

Turn off the mobile speaker prior to boarding an aircraft. Do not use during a flight.

Never place or store the mobile speaker over the area of an automobile's safety airbag deployment, as it may cause serious injury when a safety airbag activates.

## **13. Declaration of Conformity and Warranty**

The BluBridge Mobile Speaker is warranted against manufacturer defects for a period of 1 year.
