## Product Description

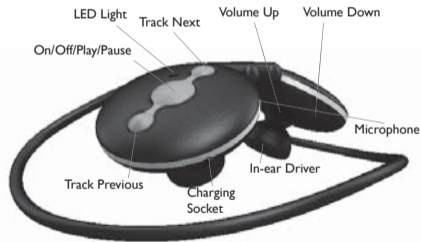
The Blubridge headphones are *Bluetooth* wireless headphones designed for the active sports enthusiast. They feature a light-weight, water and sweat resistant in-ear driver with high quality stereo sound and a built-in microphone for hands-free calling.

The talk and standby times may vary with different mobile phones; usage settings, usage styles and environments may also affect battery performance.

## Charging

The charging cable for the BluBridge headphones connects to any standard USB "Type A" port. In addition to PC's and laptops, you can also charge from a USB wall and/or automotive adapter.

1. Before first use, we recommend completely charging the headphones. The LED light will turn red while charging and turn off when finished.
2. Afterwards, each recharge cycle may take up to 2 hours.
3. If the headphones have not been used for a few months, the LED might not turn on when first charging. Please allow 15-35 minutes before the LED turns red, indicating charging.

**Note:** When battery power is low, the LED light will flash red every 15 seconds.

## Powering On/Off

Turn On: Press and hold the power button around 4 seconds until the LED turns blue.

Turn Off: Press and hold the power button around 4 seconds until the LED turns red.

**Note:** For music and calling the headset must first establish a pairing or connection with another device.

## Pairing with Mobile Phones

It is important to pair the headset with your mobile phone for the first time use.

### 1. Pairing procedure

- a. Ensure the headset is off.
- b. Press and hold the power button for 7 seconds until the LED blinks both blue and red.
- c. Using your mobile phone go to *Bluetooth* settings and select, “search for new devices.”
- d. After a few seconds your phone should find “BluBridge headphones,” select and follow the steps to complete pairing.
- e. If a pin code or password is required please use “0000”
- f. The BluBridge headphones should now be connected and ready for a work out.

The headset will automatically connect to the same phone whenever you power them both on again.

## Headphone Operations

### 1. Calling

- Answering a call: press the power button once to answer the call.
- Ending a call: press the power button once to end a call.

- Reject a call: press and hold the power button for 3 second to reject the call.
- Voice Dial: If your mobile phone has voice dialing enabled, from standby mode short press both “V+” and “V-” then say the person you wish to call.
- Last number redialing: In standby mode, double click the power button.
- Switching a call between headset and mobile phone:
  - Headset to Mobile Phone: During a call, press and hold power for 2 seconds to transfer the call to your mobile phone.
  - Mobile Phone to Headset: During a call, press and hold power for 2 seconds to transfer the call to your headset.
- Hold a call: During a call, short press “V+” button to hold the phone call. Short press “V+” button again to resume conversation.
- Mute & Unmute: During a call, Short press ”V+” and ”V-“at the same time to mute the microphone, Short press the two button again to unmute the microphone.

### 2. Playing Music

- Play/Pause: Press the power button once to switch between pause and playback.
- Volume Up: Press and hold “Volume +” to increase the volume.
- Volume Down: Press and hold “Volume –” to decrease the volume.
- Previous Track: Press “Previous” Button
- Next Track: Press “Next” Button

**Note:** Some features are dependent on the type of mobile phone or computer being used, all features may not work with some phones or devices.

Restore the Default Setting: Under standby mode, press and hold the “Track Next” button for 8

seconds until the LED flashes blue and red, then press and hold the power button for 4 seconds, then you will hear a beep, the headphone is now back to original settings.

## Using with Laptops or MacBooks

### I. Pairing procedure:

- a. Place the headphones into pairing mode by pressing the power button for 7 seconds.
- b. Verify that your laptop or MacBook has built-in *Bluetooth*, otherwise an external USB *Bluetooth* dongle is required.
- c. Open the *Bluetooth* or wireless control panel, go to *Bluetooth* settings and select “Add New Device.”
- d. Once the “BluBridge headphones” are found, select and if prompted enter pin code “0000”  
Some phones do not require this code.
- e. You should hear two beeps, one indicating stereo music connection and the other indicating hands-free connection.
- f. You are now ready to jam out and get your groove on.

## Using with Skype

- Some systems can change the sound setting automatically, allowing for a skype call right away.
- Some PC systems require a change to the settings first. Go to Skype Tools > Options > Audio settings. Then select *Bluetooth AV Audio* from the drop down menu under both the Microphone and Speakers options. Press save and now you should be able to make a Skype call with the BluBridge headphones.

## Safety Information

- To avoid damage do not drop them.
- Keep them away from humidity, water and any other liquid. If the device is exposed to water, moisture and other liquid, do not operate it to avoid any electrical shock, explosion and damage to the device or yourself.
- Do not place them near any heat source, such as, direct sun light, radiators, stoves, George Foreman grills etc. It may cause explosion or degrade the performance and/reduce battery life.
- Do not modify or disassemble them as this will void the 1 year warranty.
- Do not place heavy objects on the device.
- Replacement or service must be done by qualified service center or manufacturer.
- Unplug this device when unused for long periods of time or during lightning storms.
